The Book of Remembrance, displayed in purpose built cabinets in our Hall of Remembrance, has been provided to offer a dignified memorial in perpetuity.

As well as being viewable at the Crematorium, the book is also freely available on line at [www.gwentcrematorium.org.uk](http://www.gwentcrematorium.org.uk) There is no charge for viewing using the on-line facility.

The book has separate pages for each day. The pages are turned on a daily basis so that inscriptions appear on each anniversary according to the date chosen, which may be a birthday, date of death, wedding anniversary etc.

It is possible to reserve space within an inscription for future use.

The books themselves are hand-made and bound in the finest gold-tooled leather. All inscriptions are made by specialist, highly skilled calligraphers.

The facsimile entries in the brochure illustrate examples of the standard and attractiveness of their workmanship.

Two, five and eight line inscriptions may be chosen. A floral motif, badge, crest or other illustration may form part of a five or eight line entry.

The enclosed form should be completed by writing the surname and forenames only on the first line and the appropriate details on the remaining lines.

## *Memorial Cards*



Memorial cards may be ordered, inscribed with a copy of any entry in the Book of Remembrance, or any other suitable inscription. These are suitable not only as a keepsake, but also to send to friends and relatives who cannot easily visit the crematorium to see the original entry. Examples may be seen at the crematorium office.



## *Garden of Remembrance*

The Garden of Remembrance is divided into sixty plots, marked by numbered trees at each corner. The garden is laid to lawn and cremated remains are buried below the surface. Once a plot is full it is taken out of use and remains are then buried in the next available plot.

The garden is well maintained by our ground staff and the atmosphere is peaceful and tranquil.

**PLEASE NOTE** that it is not always possible to bury remains in the same plot in which a relative has previously been interred. However, we do endeavour to bury as near as possible to the original plot.

It is also important to note that it is not possible to exhume remains once they have been interred in the Garden of Remembrance.

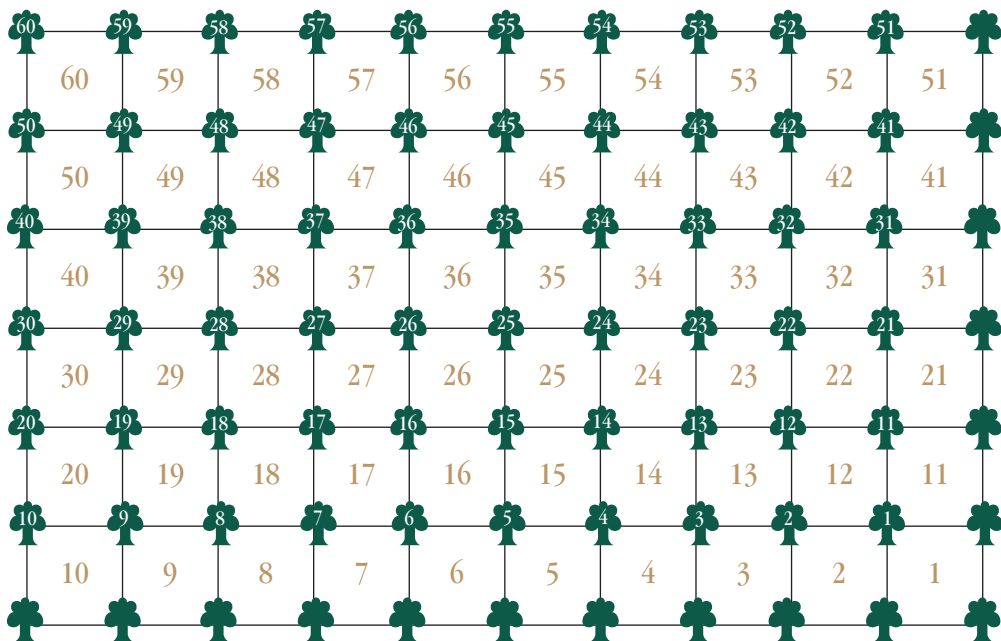
## *Memorial Garden*

The Memorial Garden is adjacent to the Garden of Remembrance. The garden is divided into sections divided by pathways and floral beds. Memorials are available for lease around the paths.

**PLEASE NOTE** that only natural flowers are permitted in the Memorial Gardens. Artificial flowers and any other unauthorised items will be removed.

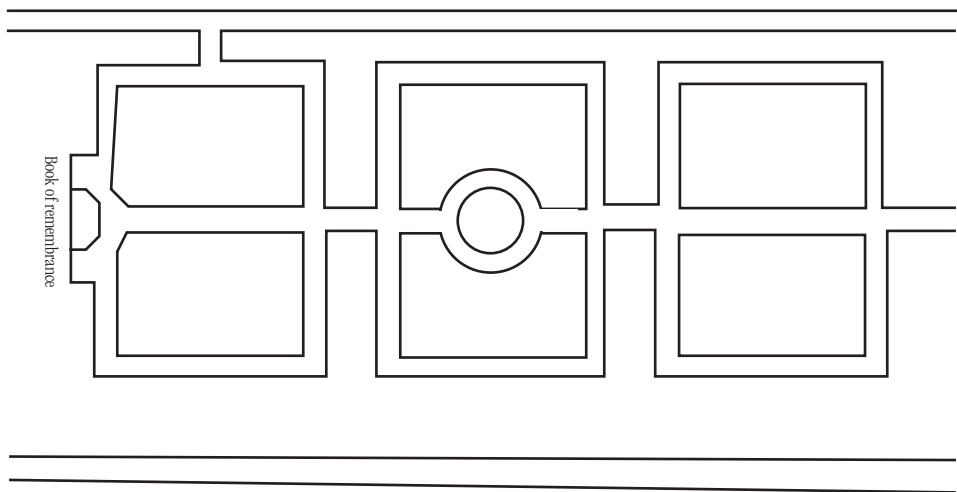


## Garden of Remembrance Layout

## Memorial Garden Layout



## *Vase Blocks*



Each vase block is made from honey coloured granite and has a plaque for your inscription and a flower vase for floral tributes.

The plaque has space for two names and inscriptions.

Vase blocks are available on a ten year lease, which is renewable after this period.



## *Sanctum 12*



The Sanctum 12 is an above ground vault in which there is space for two sets of cremated remains. The black granite fascia tablet will take a full inscription and is secured to the vault with bronze finish rosettes. The tablet incorporates a posy vase for floral tributes.

The Sanctum 12 vaults are available on lease for either 20 or 40 years. The lease may be extended at the end of the initial term.
